Kachina Doll by Bill Tarlton

What you will need:

- Banana gourd 10-12" long. You can use the end of a snake gourd as well.
- Small pear shaped gourd or small round gourd 2"-3" diameter. Proportioned to the body.
- 4"x 4" piece of hobby wood (next grade up from balsa wood)
- Hobby wood 2" 3" depending on the diameter of the banana gourd.
- 1/4" wood dowel about an inch long
- Super Glue or Two-part Epoxy
- Pencil to draw the face
- Acrylic paint or inks (your preference) and brushes or ink pads
- A piece of felt which will be attached to cover the bottom of the finished pieces
- Leather chording (attached where the Tablita attaches to the head)

Have these things done prior to class:

- Clean gourds
- Cut banana gourd to length and sand the bottom even so it will stand
- Cut out the disc to fit into the bottom of the gourd. Preferably inside as shown in the picture.
- Decide on the shape of the Tablita and draw the outline on the Hobby Wood. This is where you can really get creative (google "Tablita")
- With a piece of solder form the shape of the Tablita arch by bending the solder around the head and trace it onto the Hobby Wood. I can show you that step in class if you need help.
